12. Letter to the membership from David Freundlich, M.D. (5/28/75)

Dear Primal Friends:

During 1975, I have made several breakthroughs with the "establishment" in reference to primal. In January I made a presentation about the theory and practice of primal at Mt. Sinai Hospital in New York. The Department of Psychiatry is conservative and psychoanalytically oriented but they received the presentation with excitement. In April I was a guest of the University of Miami in Oxford, Ohio, where I presented a lecture on primal and led a 6-hour primal group with 17 graduate students in psychology. The response was very warm and enthusiastic. A paper of mine of primal experience groups has been accepted for publication in the International Journal of Group Psychotherapy, which is a traditional journal mainly concerned with analytic group approaches. Just recently a paper of mine about the theory and practice of primal has been accepted for publication in the book "Current Psychiatric Therapies", edited by Jules Masserman, M.D., who is a vice president of the American Psychiatric Association. Other recent papers include An Historical Perspective of Primal

Therapy, Methods for Reliving Primal Experiences, and Reliving Primal Experiences, Life Scripts and Re-Decisions. Although I am unable to attend the IPA conference this year, I wish you all a successful and fulfilling meeting.

MEMORANDUM TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE INSTITUTE

11/8/75

In the \$20. and \$30. dues category, membership without a subscription to Primal Community is available for \$14. and \$24. respectively.

It was pointed out by the Secretary/Treasurer that the variable cost of servicing a membership is about \$20. per year, so it is extremely difficult to reduce the bottom dues category below \$20.

Discussion of dues evolved from our desire not to exclude anyone from membership for financial reasons. The Directors feel that as many non-therapists as possible should be members of the organization. In order not to establish two classes of members (therapists and non-therapists) it was decided that this was the best way to go. We are trying very hard not to be an 'only professionals organization'.

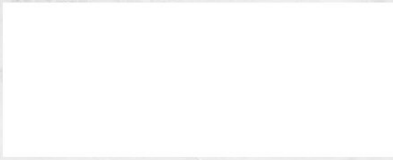
